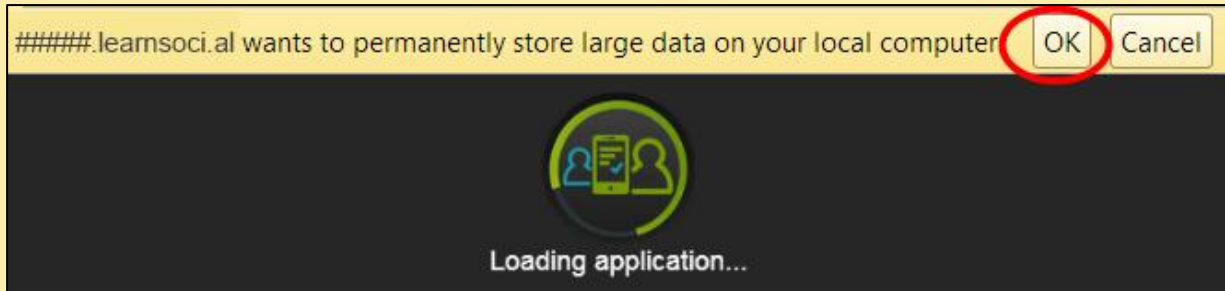
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The parts with a yellow background tint indicate something you might need to do once as part of setting up access or features etc.

Login

- Open your browser (*use the **Chrome browser** if you can: free from: www.google.com/chrome*)
- Go to <http://yourbrand.learnsoci.al>
- When you see this message (e.g. in yellow, at the top of the screen), **click OK**.
(This is to allow you to record audio and to save units to use offline when you do not have an internet connection.)

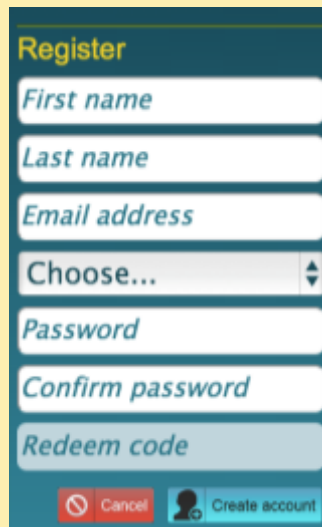


- The first time you use the platform you:
 - will see **Loading application** sign.
In future you will only have to wait for this when new units have been added.
 - need to **create an account**



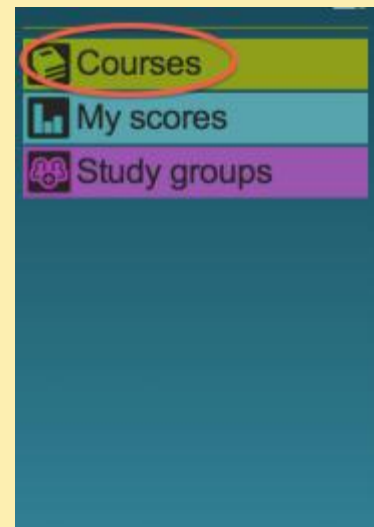
The first time you use the platform, **create an account**.

You will not be able to login until you have created an account.



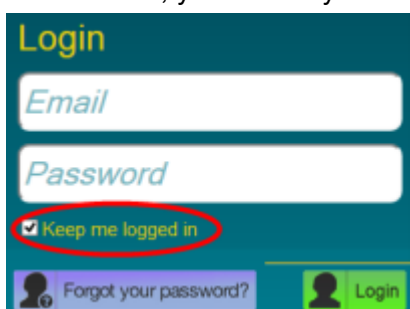
Register to create an account.
Fill out all the fields.
Your password for the platform must **be at least 8 characters**.

You will need your supplied **registration code** (“Redeem code”).
E.g. 5KHFVS373FM8DN65



When you have finished you will automatically be taken to the main menu.
Click **Courses**

- In the future, you will only need to login using your email address and platform password

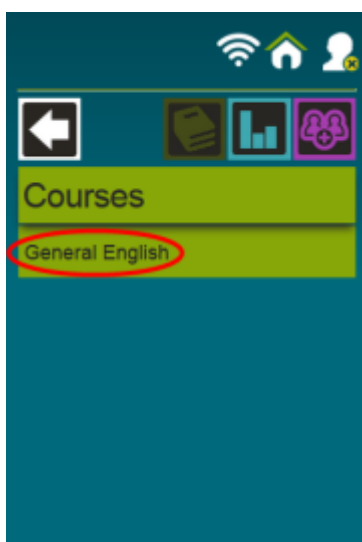


If you select **Keep me logged in**, you will not have to enter your email and platform password next time.

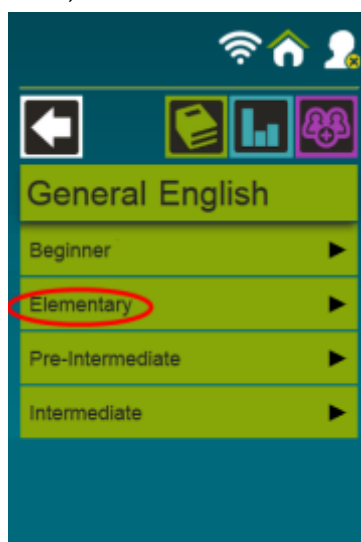
Select the **Login** button to enter the platform.

- Use the menu to choose the course, level and unit:

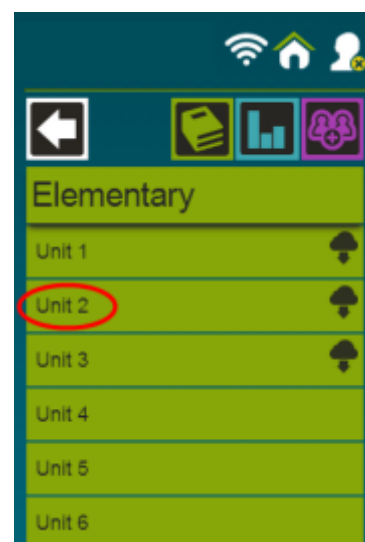


Click **General English**.

Click a unit name to try its exercises.

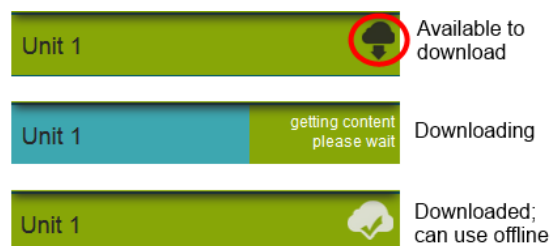
Each of the 4 levels has exercises initially for Units 1-9.

Download for offline use

If you click the cloud icon, you can download the unit. You can use a downloaded unit even if there is no internet connection.

Click this **enable offline** icon to start using downloaded units when there is no internet connection.

Read displays a piece of text needed for the exercise.



Help displays extra information.



If there is a version of the main instruction translated into a local language (*e.g. Mandarin, Vietnamese, Spanish*), this button will display it.

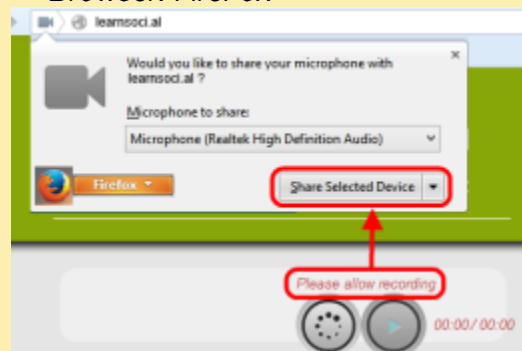
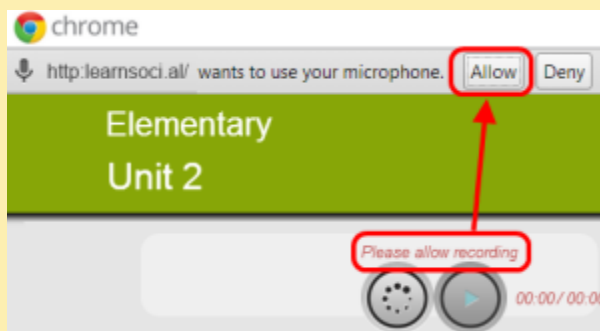

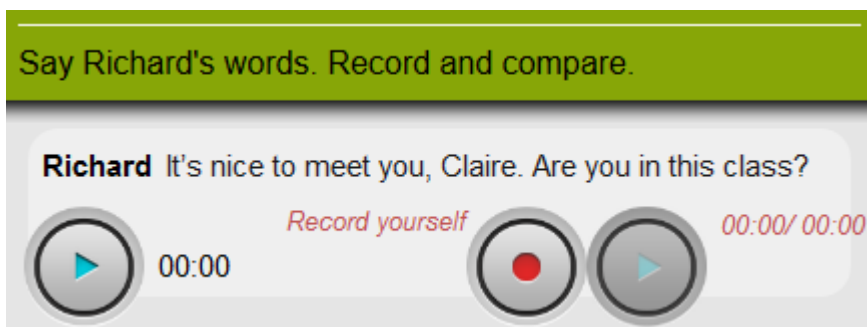
Record and Compare

Record and Compare - initial setup

The **first time** you use a “Record and Compare” Exercise, you have to **allow your browser to record your audio**. *Browser: Google Chrome* *Browser: FireFox*

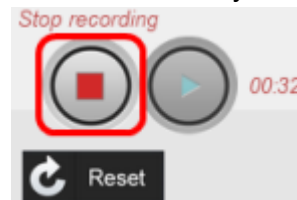


Record and Compare – doing the exercise



Listen to a recording by clicking the blue ► button on the left,

then click the red “Record” ● button to start recording an audio file of how you say the word(s)/phrase.



Click the red “Stop” ■ button to end your recording.


Click the blue “Play” ► button to listen to your recording, to compare your pronunciation to the original recording.

If you want to re-record your answer, click **Reset**

On some mobile devices, you will need to use its own recording app and select the file to submit it. On some iPhones you will be prompted “Video / Photos ?” – select “Video” to make your recording, then submit; the Platform will convert it to an audio file.

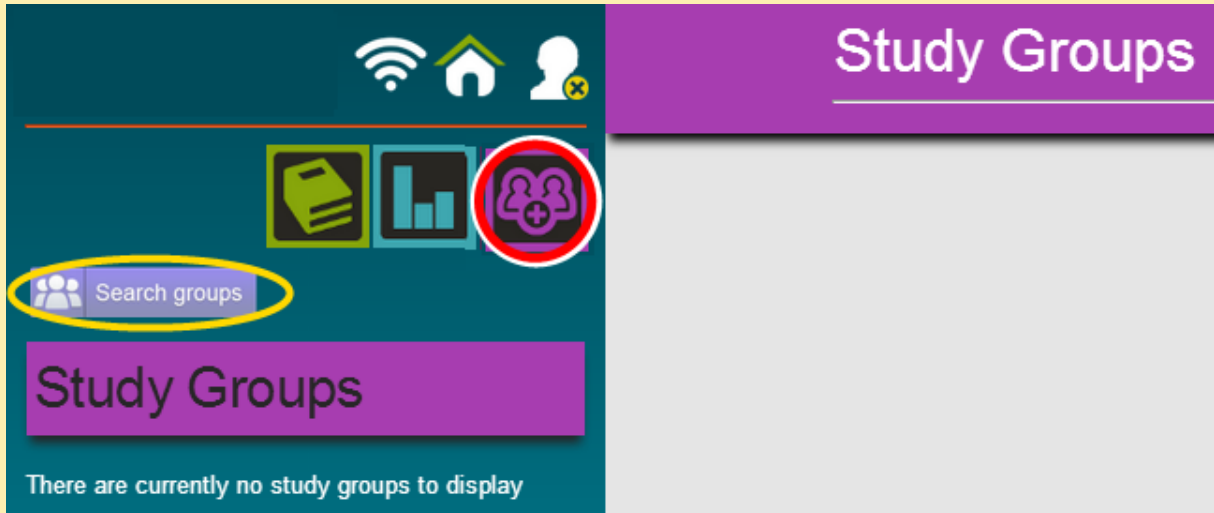

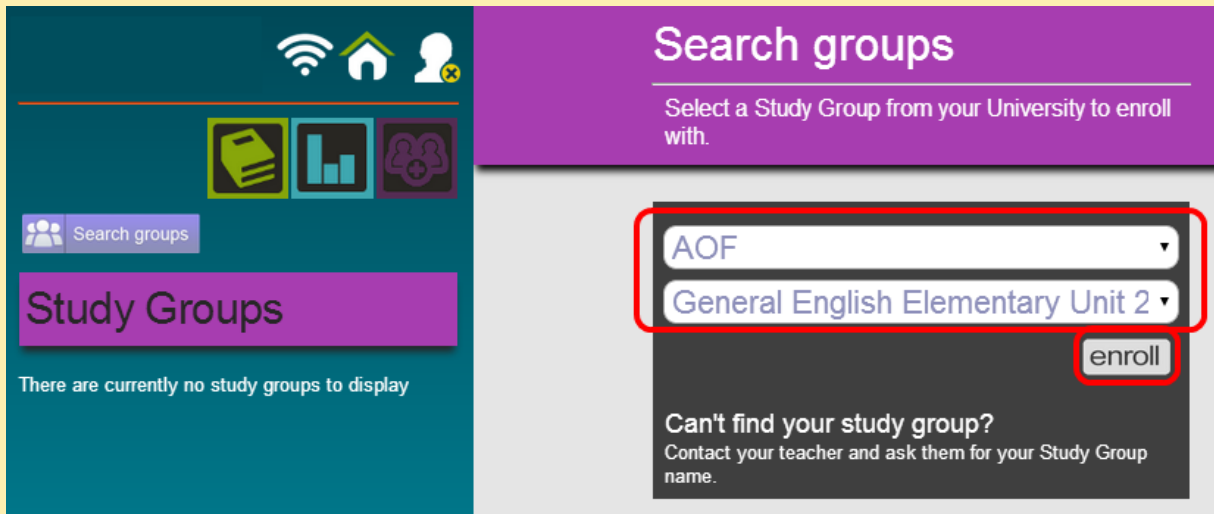
Study Groups

Click **View group** (in menu highlighted in red).

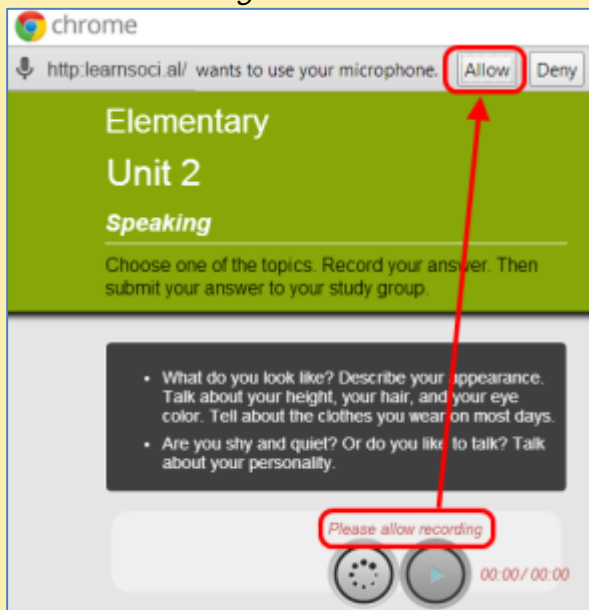

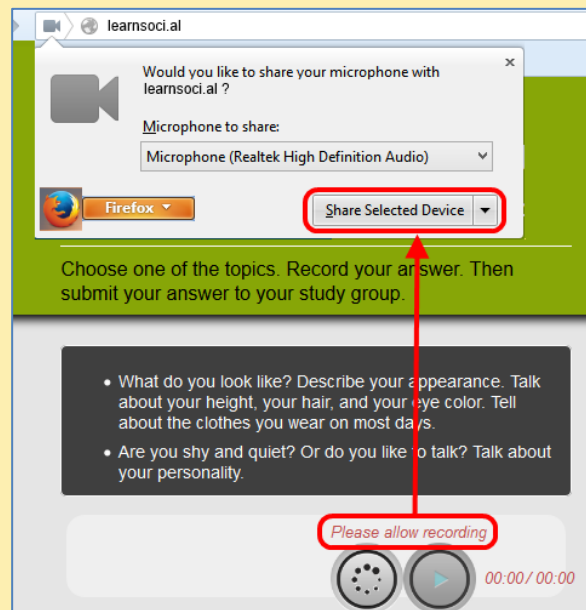

If you want to re-record their answer, they click **Reset**

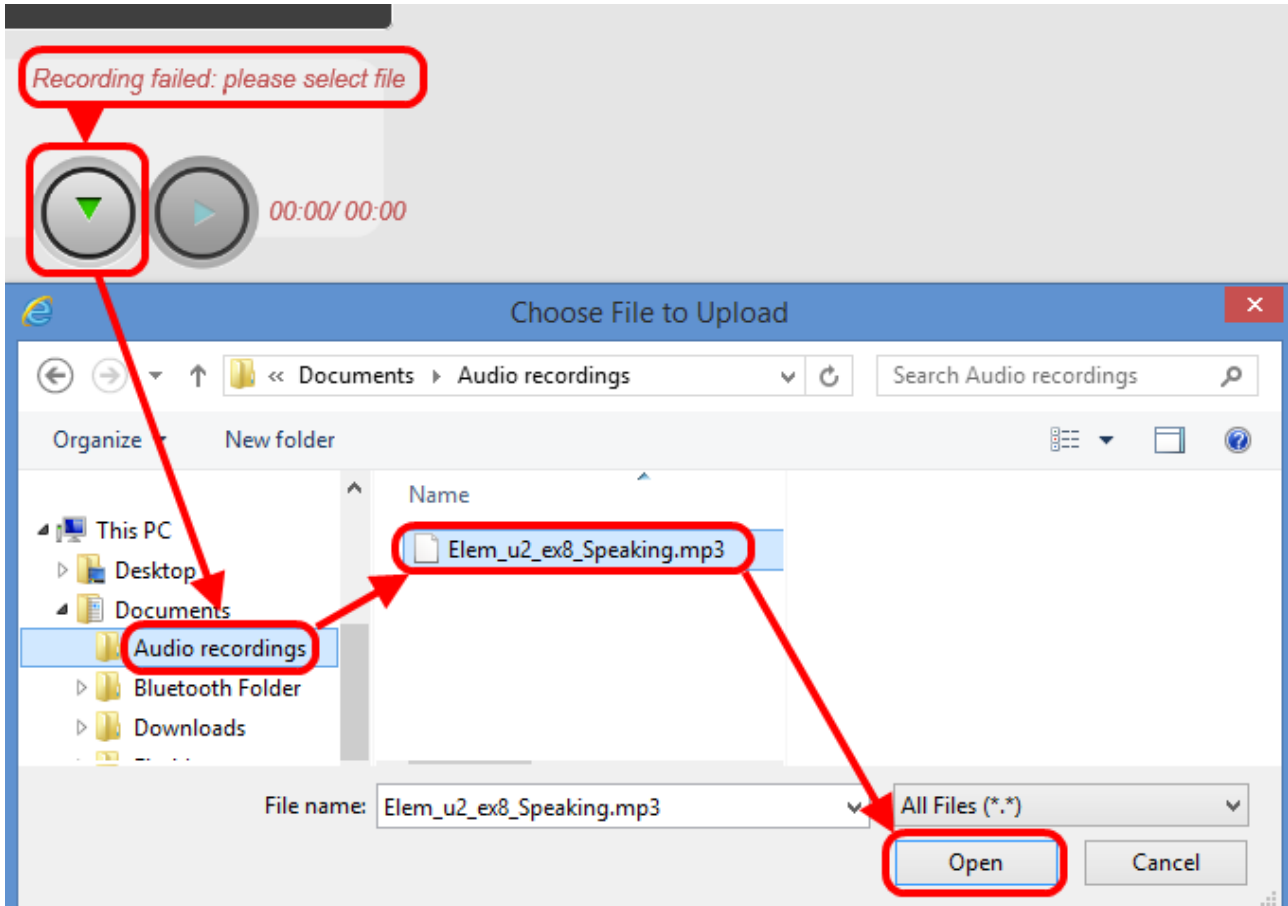
Select your **Study group** from the dropdown list (highlighted in yellow) and click **Submit**

If using a computer/laptop some older versions of browsers might not able to record audio, so you will have to record the audio with another software program or app and then upload the file.

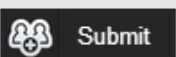

Orange panel: an exercise that has been submitted to the teacher and which is **waiting for marking (grading) by the teacher**.

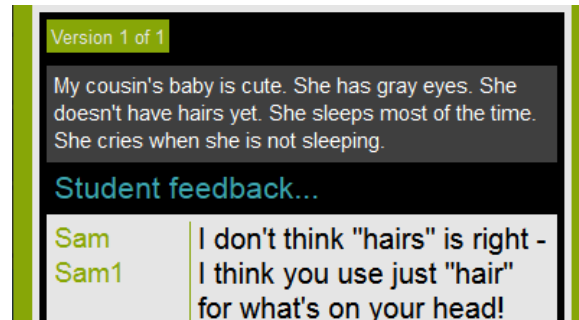
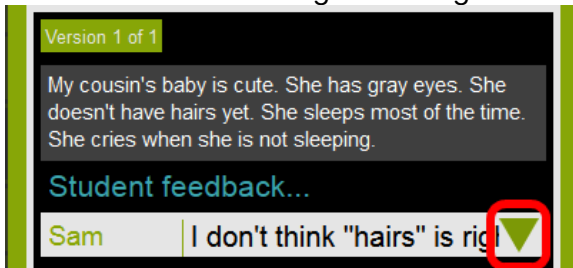
Green panel: an exercise that **has been marked (graded)** by the teacher.

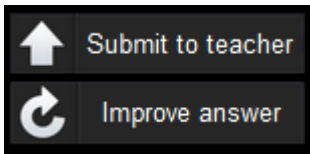


When you have feedback or want to improve your answer, or submit it to the teacher, click on a blue panel.

Click the green triangle ▼ to expand the feedback.

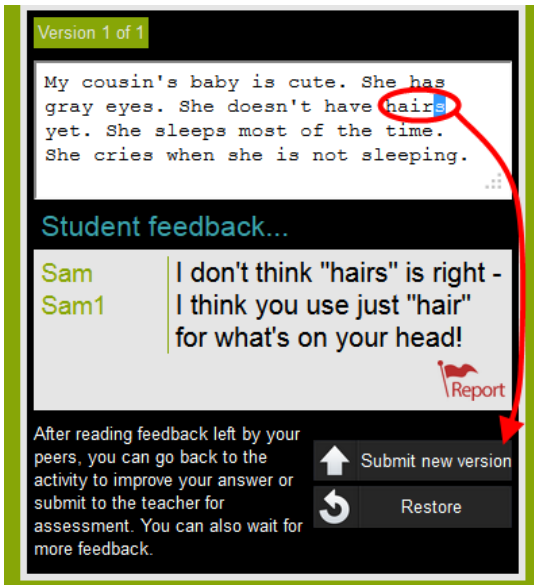




You can decide what to do next with your answer:

- **Submit to the teacher** for marking/grading
- **Improve the answer** and submit back to the group for more feedback

Improving an answer



If you decide to improve the answer, it will be submitted to the Group for review: **Submit new version**

If you try to improve your answer, but decide to go back to your original answer, use **Restore**

Submit to teacher

When your answer is ready for marking (grading) select **Submit to the teacher** and select **Yes**
