## 1. About Kyungnam University

Kyungnam University was founded in 1946 as Kookmin College in Seoul. The college moved to Masan in 1954. In 1970, the Hanma Foundation took over the college and renamed it Kyungnam College. In 1981, university status was approved and the college was then renamed Kyungnam University. Today, KU boasts 6 colleges, 19 undergraduate divisions, 10 departments, and 6 graduate schools.
