IDEAS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POSTGRADUATE BUSINESS STUDIES

The Irish Aid Development Experience and Sharing (IDEAS) scholarship programme started in 2009 and covers postgraduate study in business administration and related subjects (finance, project management, marketing, etc.). The number of scholarships awarded has increased year on year while UCD's alumni network based in Vietnam also continues to grow. Last year, we offered 25 full scholarships and these students are presently undertaking their chosen programme of study in Dublin.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is in two stages:

Step 1: Acceptance by UCD to one of the above mentioned programmes: submit on line application <u>and</u> participate in a Skype/telephone interview.

- a. Applications open from Monday October 6th 2014.
- b. FINAL APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 16th 2015.

Important points to note:

- Only complete applications will be accepted (i.e. all documents must be submitted together and incomplete applications will not be accepted)
- All applicants must have achieved the minimum score required for entry to UCD in a recognised English Language test - IELTS 6.5 overall with no lower than 6 in each band before the final application deadline of January 16th 2015.
- All English Language tests must be in date.
- All MBA Applicants must have taken the GMAT exam before the final round interviews in April 2015.
- No applications will be accepted after the final application deadline of January 16th 2015.
- We strongly encourage applicants to apply early as applications will be assessed in order of receipt.

13th February 2015: Following the review of applications and telephone interviews, applicants will be informed by e-mail whether or not they have been accepted onto a course at the UCD Michael Smurfit School of Business. Candidates will also be advised if they have been selected to move forward to the next stage of the Scholarship competition.

Step 2: Application for an Irish Aid Scholarship.

Candidates accepted onto a course in UCD are eligible to apply for an Irish Aid scholarship. Please visit the Embassy website www.embassyofireland.vn and our alumni portal www.vietnamirelandalumni.org. The deadline for receipt of completed Irish Aid Application is 6th March 2015.

13th – 17th April 2015: Final round interviews will be held in Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi. Shortlisted candidates must be available to attend for interview in either Hanoi or Ho Chi Minh City during these dates.

Successful candidates will be notified by the Irish Embassy shortly after the final round interviews have been completed.

Information Event:

An Information Event will be held both in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City in November 2014 and candidates who have applied prior to November 2014 will be invited to attend.

Summary of Eligibility Criteria:

Vietnamese Citizen residing in Vietnam	
Years of experience:	 For MSc courses: Minimum of 1 year <u>post-graduation</u> work experience. Applicants must have completed their studies prior to January 2014. For MBA course: Minimum 3 years <u>post-graduation</u> work experience in any field.
Academic qualification:	Official university degree minimum level "kha' ". Minimum GPA score of 7.0/10 (or equivalent). GMAT : 550/800 for MBA applications (GMAT is not required from MSc applicants)
Class contribution:	Ability to demonstrate a contribution to group work and interactive class discussions
Language proficiency:	English : IELTS: 6.5 overall(Academic) no lower than 6 in each band
Commitment	 Be able to demonstrate a strong commitment to the development of their home country and return to home country at the end of course. Be able to take up the fellowship in the academic year for which it is offered. Provide a letter of reference.

IRISH AID IDEAS STRAND 2 SCHOLARSHIP 2015-2016

Ireland is a world class destination for English language third level education and Irish Aid offers a number of scholarships to Vietnamese students every year.

The Irish Aid IDEAS (Development Experience and Sharing Programme) Strand 2 scholarship programme for the academic year 2015-2016 is calling for applications by candidates from Vietnam to undertake postgraduate study in higher education institutions in Ireland in technical areas such as <u>Pharmacy, Biotechnology</u>, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and Social Studies.

Additionally there will be 1 (or maximum 2) scholarship in **Applied Linguistics for English Language** lecturers from targeted institutions.

Applicants from all universities, research institutes and government agencies can apply.

The total number of scholarship is expected to be between 10-15 depending on the quality of applications and costs of training.

Scholarship awards cover: return airfare, course fees, public health insurance, a stipend to cover accommodation and subsistence costs, settling-in allowance, and book and clothing allowances (where appropriate).

Potential awardees will need to demonstrate a personal commitment to return to Vietnam following their course of study in order to make a contribution towards the development of their country.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process is in two stages:

Stage 1: Scholarship application, shortlisting by the Embassy

- Step 1: Deadline for submission of applications to the Embassy: 31 December 2014.
- Step 2: Shortlisted candidates are interviewed by the Embassy: February 2015

Stage 2: College applications, scholarship awards

- Successful shortlisted candidates to begin process of submitting college applications: April 2015
- Scholarship awards: June-July 2015
