[Definition of international applicant]

 Applicant should not be a Korean national (passport is required as proof). 2 Taiwanese applicants gualify for international status if one parent is a Korean national.

③ Applicants with dual nationality or no nationality do not meet requirements as a international applicant.

④ Applicants unable to prove their nationality through traditional means are required to submit their birth certificate. Applicants unable to prove nationality may not meet requirements for international student status.

Transferring Students

Transferring students must meet the same requirements as new applicants.
