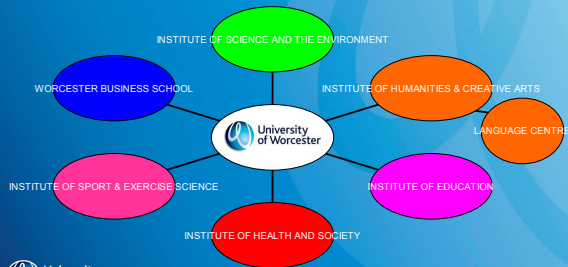
## University of Worcester

- 1000+ staff members (1 lecturer per 20 students)



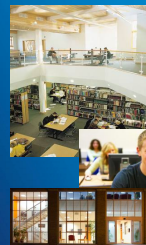

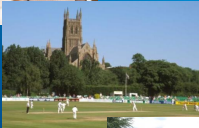
