This position is to be based in Long Xuyen, An Giang or a Central or Northern province where PALS operates.

Key Responsibilities

- Team member for the operations of PALS' Reintegration program to achieve program goals, objectives and targets and within budget
- Responsible for the operations of our Compassion Houses (CH) and Community reintegration activities
- Work directly with survivors and families
- Responsible for developing CH new activities and coordinate with volunteers for delivery of program
- Liaise with counterparts to communicate program requirements and collect reports.
- Travel to all provinces where PALS has reintegration program activities; up to 30% of travel; work will involve evenings and weekends.
- Compile documentation of program implementation, preparation and submission of periodic and final reports
- Be an integral part of the fundraising and advocacy team

Qualifications

- Minimum of 4 years of grassroots or nonprofit/NGO experience
- Prior experience with case management, crisis intervention, making referrals
- Proven experience in working in remote areas and ability to undertake frequent, tough travel conditions; willingness to work the hours necessary to get the job done including weekends and holidays
- Ability to travel out of country
- Strong coordination, facilitation and organizational skills
- Ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with local counterparts
- Commitment to foster women's rights and familiarity with women empowerment solutions
- Fluent in Vietnamese; fluency in English desired, if not, applicant must have strong English skills and ability and demonstrated commitment to increase English fluency
- Good data management skills including MS Office suites, Access, Excel; willingness to learn new technological tools
- Excellent oral and written communication skills; ethical and accountable
- Ability to work and prosper in team environment
- Bachelor degree required in Social Work or related fields
- Women are encouraged to apply
