- In charge of database entry, search and maintenance
- Provide program and logistical support to Program Coordinators and Managers
- This position will be based in Long Xuyen, An Giang, Vietnam with frequent travel throughout the country. Local hire position. Only for Vietnamese nationals or those already with permit to work in Vietnam.
